

Resolution 35-22

A Resolution authorizing the Board of Control to procure quotes from various companies and then enter into an agreement and/or agreements, without bidding, to remove asbestos and demolish the two-story structure located at 142 Depot Street, Orrville, Ohio, and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, the Design Review Board of the City of Orrville has approved the demolition of 142 Depot Street on two separate occasions; and

Whereas, the Wayne County Land Reutilization Corp. has been awarded financial assistance from the Ohio Department of Development through their Building Demolition and Site Revitalization Program; and

Whereas, the property located at 142 Depot Street has been selected as a project by the Wayne County Land Reutilization Corp. to participate in the Building Demolition and Site Revitalization Program; and

Whereas, the City of Orrville will complete the asbestos removal and demolition with its funds and will be reimbursed by the Wayne County Land Reutilization Corp.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Board of Control is hereby authorized to procure quotes from various vendors and then enter into an agreement and/or agreements, without bidding, to remove asbestos and demolish the two-story structure located at 142 Depot Street, Orrville, Ohio, and declaring an emergency.


Section 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the City of Orrville, and for the further reason that it is necessary to complete in a timely manner to take advantage of grant and market opportunities. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
