

Resolution 46-22

Section 52. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of the City of Orrville, and for the further reason that it is necessary to ensure the City of Orrville meets its financial obligations and to comply with the law as soon as possible. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
