Budget Workshop:

A budget workshop immediately followed. Specific areas of mention were a street brining system, funds for a park study, cameras for the police cruisers and the future possibility of security type cameras on poles at specific intersections and areas of high student traffic as an added measure of security for identifying vehicles or individuals possibly involved in dubious activity. Anecdotal information was shared about similar systems in Wooster and Canton. This is an item for future consideration.

Director Strimlan stated that the City's approach is to list expenses on the high side and revenues on the conservative side to avoid emergency situations where more funds would need to be requested for expenses. Mayor Handwerk thanked Strimlan for a very well-constructed and presented budget assessment. There were few questions.
