Safety-Service Director Steve Wheeler: Norfolk-Southern railroad is planning to work on the tracks in the next couple of weeks on both Main and High Streets. Schedule will be coming. Leaf pick up began today.

Finance Director Janet Strimlan: Upcoming legislation includes: Temporary appropriations which allows us to expend funds for the first three months of the years; for entering into a new agreement with local government services for our assistance with our GAP conversion for the annual audit ; and current year appropriations adjustments due to price increases. The quarterly investment report for period ending September 30, 2022, was presented for review. The Fund Balance Reports for September and October were presented with a request for motion to approve subject to audit. Wilson moved to approve; Mosley seconds; roll call vote; all ayes; motion passes.
